### **Welcome (back) to Bedford Free School!**

To those families joining us this week: a big welcome to you. And to those of returning students: welcome back. Our school family has grown again – we now have nearly 500 students!

It is the start of the year and I do not wish to inundate you with information, so I will keep today's newsletter brief:

#### **Homework Club & Golden Time this week**

Homework Club will start again from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September. It will run until 6pm Monday – Thursday, and until 5pm on Friday.

You will know that students can earn an early leave on Fridays if they keep sufficient lesson credits during the week – what we call "Golden Time". As it is the start of term, all students will be leaving school tomorrow at 3.15pm (unless they have managed to get themselves into detention!)

#### **Open events**

A couple of really important dates for you:

**Open Evening, Thursday September 25<sup>th</sup>, 6.30pm – 8.30pm**

**Open Morning, Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> October, 10am – 12pm**

As usual many of our students will be helping us with these, and in the next week or so your child may be coming home with permission slips for this.

Many schools focus these kind of events simply at prospective students and their families. **We do things differently at BFS**, and make these events a general celebration of everything that we have achieved since we opened, **so you are all invited to come along and see what we're up to!**

Please note: **we will close school at 3.15pm on the 25th**, to allow for everyone to prepare the school for the evening

Please do spread the word to prospective families too. **If you have any friends whose children have just started Year 6, please remind them that this autumn is their one chance to apply to BFS**, as we no longer have an admission point in Year 9. Given the school system in Bedford, it is a bit tricky getting our message to Year 6 students in their middle schools, so your help in publicising this would be gratefully received!

In a similar vein, if you know of families whose child is in year 7 and they are looking at their options, **we still have places for year 7.**

#### **Conduct to-and-from school**

As always, we need to ensure that all our students make their way to-and-from school in a safe and sensible fashion. We will continue to staff the pedestrian crossings near the school, and I would like to remind everyone of a few key things:

- when student wear our uniform they are the school's responsibility and must conduct themselves in an exemplary fashion
- if students travel by car then they must NOT ever be dropped off outside the school premises – the official drop off point is the Melbourne Street car park (behind Kidsworld)
- if students come by bike they MUST have reflectors and lights by the time we reach October
- students are NOT allowed in Farm Foods or the St Mary's Street Post Office before or after school.

We have only ever had literally a couple of concerns raised about our students' conduct since the school opened – which is brilliant. Our distinctive uniform makes spotting our students easy – and business and shopkeepers in the area have been asked regularly to pass back any feedback to me. I am grateful for your support with this.
