Homework

Drop off / Pick up

Drop off / pick up must happen in the designated travel plan place of Melbourne Street, Car Park, (and absolutely NOT outside school or anywhere along Cauldwell Street). This arrangement is in accordance with requirements from the Local Authority and in order to keep pupils, families and others safe. For any breaking these rules, parking tickets may be issued and corrections will be given to pupils.

Arrival time

Please remember that the gates close immediately as the clock strikes 8:25am. There are a minority of pupils who are compromising the smooth start to the school day by arriving after this time. Thank you to all those pupils who arrive comfortably by 8:20am when the bell rings.
